## Research on the *Hebrew Bible* by Chinese Scholars in the Past 30 Years

**Abstract:** The establishment of diplomatic relations between China and Israel in 1992 promoted the upsurge of Chinese scholars to study Jewish traditional culture. The *Hebrew Bible*, as a Jewish religious classic, has increasingly attracted academic attention. This paper summarizes the academic research achievements in the past 30 years from the aspects of multi-dimensional text research of the *Hebrew Bible*, the *Hebrew Bible* and the ancient history of Israel, the comparative study of the *Hebrew Bible* and other classics, and the cross text stress between the *Hebrew Bible* and Chinese traditional culture.
